



iscovery Museun

Established in 1985, the Coastal Discovery Museum offers hands-on exploration of the Lowcountry's diverse cultural heritage and complex natural history with an array of programs, presentations, exhibits and tours for all ages.

The last significant parcel of open space on Hilton Head Island, the Coastal Discovery Museum at Honey Horn opened to the public in 2007.

Comprising 68-acres of salt marsh and maritime forests, centuriesold live oaks, open fields and a dozen historic structures, Honey Horn is located at the intersection of Highway 278 and the Cross Island Expressway.

Over its 300-year history, Honey Horn has been home to Indian tribes, indigo and Sea Island cotton plantations, Gullah families who hunted and farmed the land, a hunt club established by northern businessmen and, starting in 1950, Fred Hack's private residence and farm.

In the late 1990s, the Town of Hilton Head Island purchased the site and leased it to the Coastal Discovery Museum for 95 years.

Construction of the 6,000-squarefoot hunting lodge began in 1859 and, today, is known as the Discovery House, complete with permanent and temporary exhibits, a Kids Zone and gift shop.

Self-auided tours of the property via salt marsh boardwalks and an oyster shell trail include the new Karen Wertheimer Butterfly Enclosure, a Lowcountry Heritage Garden and a Camellia Garden.

Guided History/Nature Walks & Talks, live animal programs and seasonal kids camps are offered on a regular basis.

Off-site tours and programs include the Gullah Heritage Trail Tour, Forts of Port Royal, Beach Discovery, Turtle Talks & Walks and much more.

This historic property is also available to rent for romantic wedding receptions, corporate events and is home to some of the Island's largest annual festivals.

The Town of Hilton

Head Island provides over 50 miles of public pathways and nature trails for the enjoyment of pedestrians and cyclists.

At low tide, the Island's 12 miles of beaches are also ideal for biking. Public beaches are indicated on The Official Guide's Island Maps.

GUIDE

Our maps also show the existing public pathways. Many kiosks are located along the pathways with an Island-wide map on one side, and a localized map of the area on the other.

RULES FOR THE ROAD

Please obey all traffic signals and pathway markings. Stop signs must be obeyed for safety. Bicycles are vehicles and must obey SC traffic laws.

Travel the pathways at speeds that allow for the safety of pedestrians and other users.

Never ride within the roadway against traffic. State law requires bicycles to drive like all other vehicles.

Please do not ride on roads where a pathway is available.

Please ride single file and keep a safe distance from other bicyclists.

WATCH OUT FOR MOTORISTS! Motorists must yield to pedestrians and bicyclists within marked crossings, but they may not see you.

Please yield to pedestrians. When resting or stopped, please move off the pathway.

Most sections of the pathways are not illuminated. If you must bike at night, please wear light-colored clothing or carry a flashlight. Bicycles must have a red rear reflector and a headlight when biking at night.

When approaching slower pathway users from behind, please sound your warning device, or call out, "Passing on your left." Always pass on the left.

> Bicyclists should always wear a helmet, especially children 12 and under.

Make eye contact and use hand signals. Assume other bicyclists and motorists don't see you. Hand signals tell motorists and other path users what you intend to do and will ensure everyone's safe enjoyment of the pathways.

Be courteous, alert and predictable.

Sea Pines Forest Preserve

Established by the Fraser family in 1959, the Sea Pines Forest Preserve covers more than 600 acres within The Sea Pines Resort. Today, this former Indian hunting ground features a prehistoric shell ring, pathways following antebellum rice dikes and

old logging trails, four lakes and several small ponds, bridle paths, biking trails, wetland boardwalks, bridges, observation decks, fishing docks and picnic areas. Admission into the forest preserve is free, a Sea Pines gate pass is required. (843) 671-1343 or seapinesliving.com.



Audubon Newhall Preserve

Maintained by the Hilton Head Audubon Society, this 50-acre nature preserve located on Palmetto Bay Road includes a series of short, interconnected, interpretive trails showcasing a variety of native plants and shrubs, as well as a rare pocosin (bog).

Open during daylight hours, admission is free. Trail Guides are available at the gate or can be viewed online at **sctrails.net**. Guided Walks led by Master Gardeners and naturalists are offered at select times throughout the year, call (843) 842-9246 for walk details and reservations.



Pinckney Island National Wildlife Refuge

Once a cotton plantation managed by the Charles Cotesworth Pinckney family, Pinckney Island was donated to the Fish and Wildlife Service in 1975. Now a part of the Savannah Coastal

Refuges Complex, Pinckney Island encompasses 4,053 acres, including four islands, salt marsh, tidal creeks and freshwater ponds, between Hilton Head Island and the mainland. Observe large concentrations of white ibis, herons and egrets, plus wading bird rookeries, waterfowl, shorebirds, raptors, neo-tropical migrants, osprey nests and a bald eagle nest from the hiking and biking trails. Fishing By Season: Winter

We have the opportunity to catch these fish all winter...

Redfish on the flats is the name of the game this season.

We have the opportunity to catch these fish all winter and into the spring, as our estuary system is loaded with large mud flats that hold one to two feet of water at dead low tide. Perfect habitat for Redfish.

As the water cools down in late fall, Redfish tend to school. This is simply a survival technique.

Redfish are the number one food source for our resident Bottlenose Dolphin. The dolphin push the edges of these flats in small groups and try to corral a school of fish. It is something to see them feeding on an eight-pound Redfish. They also help us locate the fish with their feeding activity.

Given calm winds and clear water, these Redfish schools are not hard to find, by either seeing them "push a wake" as they move down the flat or simply seeing the dark color of the mass of fish.

Once we find them, we normally try to get into casting range as quietly as possible and stake the boat down. Stealth is important in catching Redfish and the more noise one makes in the boat, the fewer opportunities you will have to pull one in.

Baits vary at this time of year. Cut mullet, shrimp, mud minnows,

spoons and soft plastics all work, but my choice is free lining a Gulp – hands down the best bet for a hookup I have seen.

For fly fisherman, this is the ultimate challenge. Sight casting to Redfish is big-time business all along the Southeast and Gulf coasts and the Lowcountry of South Carolina is as good as you can find. We have numerous days of putting 10 to 20 Redfish in the five- to 10-pound class in the boat on a four-hour trip.

Most of our trips in the winter are four-hour trips, built around the last two hours of the outgoing tide and the first two hours of the incoming. This gives us maximum exposure to that window of opportunity in finding the fish.

What a great way to spend a January afternoon. Beats shoveling snow all to pieces!







ISLAND BEACHES

PUBLIC BEACH ACCESS:

All of the beach is public, from the ocean to the high water mark. Access to the beach, however, is often private. The Town of Hilton Head Island provides nine beach accesses: Alder Lane Beach Access, off South Forest Beach Drive; Coligny Beach Park, off Coligny Circle; Driessen Beach Park, at the end of Bradley Beach Road; Chaplin Community Park, off Wm. Hilton Pkwy.; Fish Haul Park & Mitchelville Beach Park, at the end of Beach City Road; Burkes Beach Access, at the end of Burkes Beach Road: Folly Field Beach Park and Islanders Beach Park, both off Folly Field Road.

PARKING & FACILITIES:

There are 23 metered spaces at Alder Lane; 54 metered spaces at Folly Field and 13 metered spaces at Burkes Beach Road. The parking fee is a QUARTER for each 15 minutes. Additionally, there are 207 spaces at Driessen Beach Park for long-term parking. The fee is a QUARTER for each 30 minutes during the week.

Parking spaces at Islanders Beach Park are ALWAYS reserved for annual beach passes. Parking at Driessen Beach Park for annual beach passes is reserved from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Parking is FREE at Fish Haul Park, Mitchelville Beach Park and Coligny Beach Park. Handicap parking is available at no fee at all beach parks.

Restrooms, changing areas, sand showers and vending machines are available at the beach parks.

DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREAS:

Official swimming areas have been designated for the Alder Lane, Coligny, Driessen, Folly Field and Islanders Beach Parks. The boundaries will be clearly marked on the beach and in the water.

During the beach season, lifeguards are stationed in each of the designated swimming areas for assistance and beach information. Please ask a lifeguard before entering the water if the yellow caution flag is flying.

BEACH MARKER SIGNS:

Hilton Head's beaches are marked with signs to let emergency responders know where anyone who needs help is on the beach. They are also useful to help you find your place if you are lost on the beach. It is helpful for everyone in your group to know the marker where you are staying, so that you can return on your own or tell beach patrol personnel, so they can get you back to the right place. The markers sit near the dune line.

BEACH PROHIBITIONS: The following are prohibited on all beaches:


- Possession or consumption of alcohol
- Glass (bottles, containers, etc.)
- Littering
- Indecent exposure or nudity
- Disorderly conduct
- Disturbing the peace
- Unauthorized vehicles
- Fires and fireworks
- Shark fishing
- Horse riding or driving
- Removal, harming, or harassment of any live beach fauna (sea turtles, sand dollars, etc.)

- Removal, alteration, or damage to dunes, sea oats, or other dune flora
- Operation, launching, or landing of unauthorized motorized watercraft
- Unauthorized commercial activity
- Sleeping on the beach between midnight and 6 a.m.
- Unauthorized wearing of life guard emblems, insignias, etc.
- Solicitation or distribution of
- handouts
- Kites not under manual control
- Parasailing

ANIMALS must be on leash or under positive voice control October 1 – March 31. Persons in control of animals on the beach are required to remove and properly dispose of the animal's excrement. Ordinance signs are posted at most beach access points.

During lunch, the variety of salads, sandwiches, burgers, seafood platters and daily specials are sure to please every palate. In the evening, the menu expands to include an even larger selection of appetizers and entrees, such as stuffed flounder, stuffed mushrooms and Alaskan king crab legs.

From fresh fish and tender sea scallops to succulent shrimp and plump oysters, patrons may choose their seafood broiled, fried or steamed with a garden salad, cornon-the-cob, coleslaw, onion rings,



rice, baked potato or French fries on the side.

SONYA'S SWEET POTATO CORNBREAD

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 lb. sweet potatoes, peeled and diced
- 2 cups sugar
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 2 cups fine cornmeal
- 2 cups all-purpose flour

- 1 Tbsp. cinnamon
- 1/2 Tbsp. jerk seasoning
- 1/2 Tbsp. nutmeg
- 2 Tbsp. baking powder
- 1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce





METHOD:

Put potatoes in a pot and cover with water. Add 1 1/2 cups sugar and boil until tender. Remove potatoes and continue to let the water boil until thick (syrup for the bread). Put all other dry ingredients in a bowl and mix in applesauce and enough water until a pancake batter consistency. Add sweet potatoes. Put batter in a greased 9x13 pan and bake at 350 degrees for about an hour and a half. Add syrup to warm bread and serve.
